At GRE if a teacher wants me to be silent, he or she will raise their fist in the air.






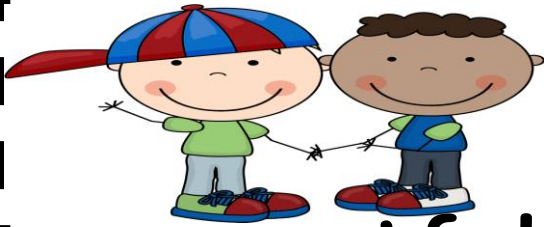
Here is what it looks like:

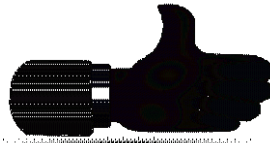
